**1st prize:** The 15kg of Tails Up frozen ready-mades, plus a tub each of matching dip and pop-ups, goes to Carl Coley from Whitton, Middlesex, who appeared in issue 634 with this lake record and personal best 40lb 10oz mirror from a southern stillwater. Carl used Tails Up's Protavit Liver ready-mades during his five-hour morning session to tempt the venue's first ever 40-pounder.



**2nd prize:** Darren Belton from Tunbridge Wells, Kent, takes the Carp-Tech Goliath sleeping bag for his capture of this 40¼lb mirror during a four-day stint on a MKF venue. The 36-year-old railway worker appeared in issue 633, and used Tails Up's Far Eastern ready-mades.



**3rd prize:** This 40lb 2oz mirror was caught during an eight-hour session on a Lea Valley pit, and it wins five kilos of Tails Up frozen ready-mades plus five kilos of pellets for captor Phil Shewan from St Albans, Hertfordshire. Tails Up's SC25 frozen ready-mades did the job for the 29-year-old warehouseman, who appeared in issue 634.



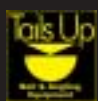
**Free bait -- Free bait -- Free bait -- Free bait -- Free bait**

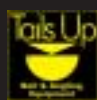

**5th prize:** goes to Ray Bundock from Stockport, Cheshire, for his capture of this 39lb mirror (above), which topped an 11-fish catch during a four-day stint on an Oxfordshire pit. A new bait on test from Tails Up proved successful for the 42-year-old Royal Mail manager, who appeared in issue 632.
